

## Recent developments in international salt trade

Last year, Salt Partners were flying over some of the world largest solar saltfields. We saw empty stockpiles and broken dykes. The Asia-Pacific chloralkali industry depends on high quality salt from Australia. High quality means less than 0.04% calcium, less than 0.02% magnesium and less than 0.12% sulphate. Such salt is required for smooth operation, low cost of brine purification and non-polluting caustic-chlorine production.

How does the shortage of high quality Australian salt effect the international trade? How do the salt prices react?  
Can India fill the gap?
